To My Church Family:

We have made it to December, the new year (2023) is just around the corner, and well, can you believe it? I know I cannot. As we live in what we call the post Covid world, Grace has taken what we have been given and made the most of everything we could. Now it has not been a seamless year, I would be lying if I said it had. Like everyone else in this area that we call our own backyard, the church has felt the good and bad of the year. We watched our electric bill go up and up. We watched the costs of our everyday expenses go up and up. We even watched the cost of having insurance for our church property go up and up. And sadly, our revenue to expenses is going to fall short, just a bit. For some, this may seem like the time to hang our heads in doubt, but we cannot forget that we have taken what we have been given and made the most of everything we could. So, for the sake of 2023, let's look at some of what this means.

Our budget is about to be approved by the Session during December. Had pledges stayed the way giving came in for 2022, compared to expenses, it was going to look very scary. But as of the time of writing this letter, we are pledged at \$263,800, an increase of \$27,600 from \$236,200 pledged for 2022 (thank you to the Ministry of Finance and Stewardship for your hard work). And we are doing this with the anticipation to meet and exceed all of our needs for 2023! Will you give faithfully in 2023?

And how about the amazing Trunk-or-Treat event we hosted with the help of the Ministry of Care, the Ministry of Christian Education, the Presbyterian Women, the Men of the Church, and the countless volunteers that made it happen? With an estimated 600-700 friends and family joining us on our property, it was an absolutely spectacular evening (thank you to Tabitha Speed for helping coordinate it all)! But this means we have to plan for bigger and better for next year. Will you volunteer faithfully in 2023?

And how about the wonderful work that is done each week through Grace Cares, serving on average 120-150 bags of food per week? We are doing this on top of the weekly financial aid we provide. But this is not the only benevolent cause that we support. Operation Christmas Child was as big as ever (thank you Joyce Bright and Jamie Williams for your hard work with this)! But we do not stop there with our giving. We have missionaries we support. We have families in our community we support. We have schools and non-profit groups we support. And the list goes on and on from here. Will you serve faithfully in 2023?

If you are anything like me, you are tired from the incredible year we had in 2022! But if you also anything like me, you would not trade it for all the world! I have absolutely loved 2022, even with all its up and downs, but I cannot wait to see what 2023 has instore for us! So, I have just one last question to ask: Will you joyfully walk with me in 2023?
